Election of Directors - 2023 Onwards

Your chance to help shape the future of Tamworth Co-operative Society

The Society has a Board of nine Directors elected by our Members. Directors normally serve a three year term and may subsequently submit nominations for further terms. Appointments are made each year at the Society Annual General Meeting, which takes place normally in April or May each year. Under the Society Rules nominations have to be received around the end of the calendar year for the AGM in the following year. Remuneration is applicable for these important positions.

You don't need to have any particular experience as training will be provided but you do need to be a Member of the Society, interested in us and be a customer spending at least £250 each year. If successfully elected to the Board there is a requirement to spend £500 annually with the Society. Please note that the spending requirement comes from the Society Rules and has to be verified each year either by the Dividend Card or by submitting receipts. The Rules restrict the number of employees or retired employees that can be on the Board at any time. Please note that to be eligible to be a Director you need to have been a Member of the Society for at least two years.

The Society has been trading for over 130 years and now operates 12 Food Stores and 8 Funeral locations. We have Post Offices located in 4 of our Food Stores and we have significant property interests. We are a community based Society and support a number of local groups each year.

Our Board work closely together as a team and the key requirement is for an interest in Tamworth Co-operative Society rather than having any particular type of experience. Further information is available on the Society at our website www.tamworth.coop
