COMMITTEE'S REPORT.

FELLOW-MEMBERS—We have much pleasure in submitting for your approval the Eighty-sixth Quarterly Report and Balance Sheet.

The net Sales for the Quarter have been £22,684. 12s., and are an increase on the previous Quarter of £764. 17s. 9d., and on the corresponding period of last year of £2,034. 18s. 1d.

The Profits enable us to recommend a Dividend of 2s. 4d. in the £. The Balance disposable (including £120 brought forward from last Quarter), after providing for Depreciation, Interest, and all Expenses, amounts to £2,706. 6s. 1½d., which it is proposed to dispose of as follows:—

The Bread Baked, including Currant Bread, has been 44,279 stones, an increase on last Quarter of 1,123 stones, and over the corresponding Quarter of last year of 2,931 stones.

The present number of Members is 3,325.

The Orchard Street extensions and alterations have cost the Society £6,411. 3s. 8d., inclusive of Building, Fixtures, Machinery, Lighting and Heating, Alterations, and Engineer's and Architect's charges. The whole of the charges—Architect, £277. 11s. 8d.; Engineer, £58. 5s. 6d.; and Alterations, £278—have been paid out of current account in the quarters in which the bills were received, as although the greater portion of it might be legitimately placed to Buildings Account, we deemed it preferable to pay them off.

Our Confectionery Department was commenced on April 9th, and so far it has done well, but when fully made known to our members should considerably increase upon what we are now doing. Our goods are of first-class manufacture, all the ingredients used being of the purest nature, so that the quality cannot be surpassed. In asking you to make your purchases of all kinds of Cakes and Pastry Goods, we are confident of suiting your tastes. To this department we contemplate adding very soon a tea room for the use of our members.

We are pleased to say that consideration has been given to a more frequent delivery of Bread and a more efficient delivery of Groceries in the district, and, although we are not just now in a position to publish the new list of deliveries, when the alterations are made we hope our members will appreciate it, and that our efforts will result in an increased trade.

It was in the 75th Quarter you decided, upon our recommendation, to have a twelve-week Quarter, so that our accounts would comply with the law in the making-up of the return supplied to the Chief Registrar of Societies under the Industrial and Provident Societies Act. By a similar arrangement in the 61st Quarter, the time between the end of the Quarter and the Quarterly meeting has been too much extended. The date of the Quarterly meetings is fixed by rule to be held on the THIRD Wednesday in the months of March, June, September, and December. We now recommend you to alter these dates to the FIRST Wednesday of these months, and to say that Pass Books shall be sent in for Audit by the 6th of the month preceding. This arrangement will then come into force on January 1st, 1909, and it will necessitate Rules 19 and 22 being altered accordingly.

We have had made to us an offer which we think must be unique in the history of a Co-operative Distributive Society. The Rev. Wm. Mc.Gregor, M.A., of Bolehall, offers to this Society, as a "deed of gift," subject to certain conditions, which conditions will be read to the members at the Quarterly meeting, the building situate in Church Street, Tamworth, and adjoining our own premises there, known as the BATHS and INSTITUTE, containing a large room in which is a swimming bath, which, except for five months of the year, can be covered over and the room used for public meetings, &c.; also rooms of various size suitable for lecture, reading, or library rooms. We have examined the building and carefully considered the conditions which reserve the use of some of the buildings, and we ask you to accept the reverend gentleman's offer of the Baths and Institute.

Co-operative Insurance.—In making provision against a "rainy day" by accumulative Dividends, also make provision against Fire, &c., and insure through your own Society. Proposals for Insurance against Fire, &c., can be effected by us, and Proposal Forms may be had on application at the office.

Withdrawals of Share Capital and Dividends can only be paid to the actual owner of the Shares, unless the person sent is provided with written authority and a Notice of Withdrawal Form duly signed by such owner of Shares. The Share Pass Book and Pass Card must be produced whenever a contribution to or a withdrawal from Shares is made.

Share, Building (Mortgage), and Penny Bank Books should be sent in regularly on or before dates given on almanac, and the importance of this cannot be too strongly impressed upon Members. When left the Pass Card should have the amount standing in the Share Book entered thereon and same initialled.

The Current Quarter ends on July 27th, and Share Books should be sent in by the 20th day of month following.

Dividends will be paid on **Thursday, Friday, and Saturday, June 18th, 19th, and 20th**, between the hours of 10 a.m. to 12 noon, 2 p.m. to 4 p.m., and 6 p.m. to 7-30 p.m. Children should not be sent to draw Dividends.
