COMMITTEE'S REPORT.

FELLOW-MEMBERS,

In submitting for your consideration and approval the Ninety-ninth Quarterly Balance Sheet, ending July 24th, 1911, we are pleased to call your attention to some of the outstanding features therein. The subjoined accounts reveal very gratifying results, and show that the business of the Society is extending rapidly; especially is it evident in the Furnishing, Drapery, Clothing, and Boot and Shoe Departments.

The **SALES** for the Quarter are £24,618. 8s. 5½d., an increase on the corresponding Quarter of last year of £2,833. 10s. 2½d.; they are a decrease on last Quarter's Sales of £840. 11s. 4d., the season of the year being accountable for this.

The **PROFITS** are well maintained, and for the Quarter the Trade Profit is £3,477. 12s. 11½d., as against £3,792. 18s. 9d. for last Quarter, a decrease of £315. 5s. 9½d., and against £2,899. 8s. 2d. for the corresponding Quarter of last year, an increase of £578. 4s. 9½d.

The **MEMBERSHIP** has increased by 103, and now stands at 3,870, whilst their Share Capital is £40,705. 4s. 10½d.

The **BAKERY OUTPUT** of Bread for the Quarter is 50,490 stones, a decrease on the last Quarter of 46, but an increase on the corresponding Quarter of last year of 2,105 stones.

During the Quarter, *i.e.*, on June 15th, 1911, we removed the Bespoke Tailoring Department to the Shop, 119, Lichfield Street, Tamworth. This Department is going ahead, and, now that the convenience for Members and the facilities for doing more work are better provided for, we hope that we shall still further be entrusted with orders, and that much trade will be done. The adjoining shop will shortly be opened, and will be used for the sale of Gents' Outfitting and Hosiery. These two shops should be a considerable convenience to Members in that part of the town in which they are situated, and should prove busy and lucrative departments of the Society.

For some time the Committee have had under consideration methods for the easier and quicker production of Bread, and their deliberations conclude in the opinion that it is necessary to have built two more ovens of the type of Messrs. Werner, Pfeleiderer, and Perkins Limited two deck patent Draw-plate Ovens. It is proposed to fix these at the Halford Street end of the premises, where, at present, is the cooling shed. There will have to be built other accommodation for loading, and some permanent alteration made. It is our intention to call, in the very near future, a Special Meeting of Members, to whom particulars will then be given. The plan accepted will not inconvenience to any great extent the production of Bread whilst the work is in progress, and when the ovens are completed more Bread can be baked, and with shorter hours of labour for the staff.

Thanking you for your past trade and hoping the Society will be favoured with still increased support by you, which will lead to a yet more successful record,

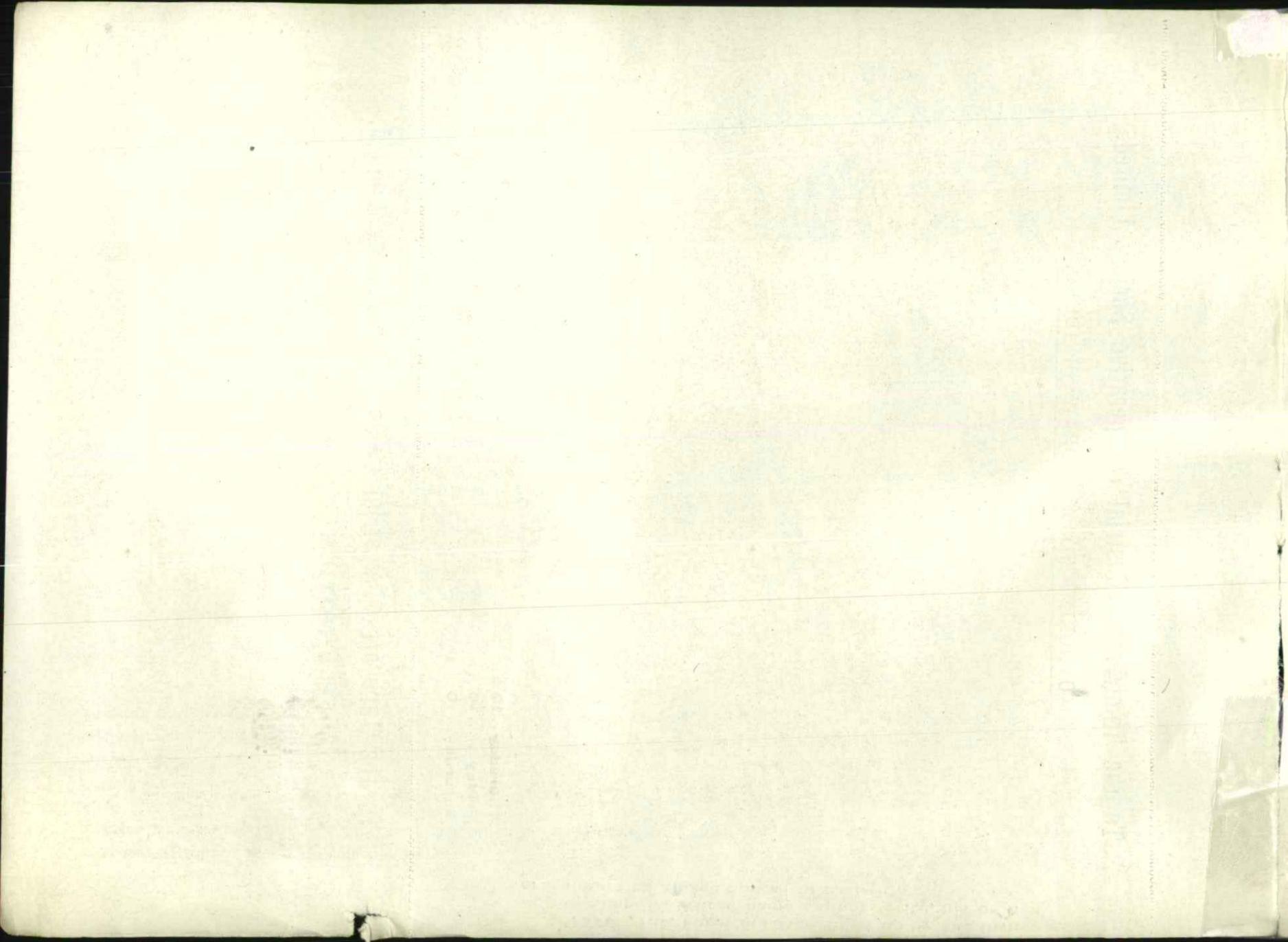

Payment for Goods may be made to the deliverer who delivers same, or at either of the Shops—Colehill or Orchard Street.

Clothing Club—Easy Payments: Subscriptions to this are received at any time. The amount so received being from 6d. to 5s. All moneys must be expended in the Drapery, Clothing, Boot, Coal, or Furnishing Departments.

Members' Attention is directed to Rule XX., whereby they may nominate the party to whom the money standing to their credit may be paid at their decease. If Members would attend to this rule the money could be transferred at their death free of expense, and those entitled to receive the money saved a considerable amount of trouble.

Small Savings Bank.—Deposits are received at any time during office hours. Sums from One Penny to Ten Shillings may be deposited, but not more than £20 can be on deposit at one time. Interest at the rate of £4. 3s. 4d. per cent per annum is paid on each sum of Four Shillings remaining on deposit for three months.

Members Changing their Address should intimate the same to the Secretary. A Form is placed at the end of this Report for that purpose, and much annoyance will be saved to the staff if we can be advised of any alteration.

Co-operative Insurance.—In making provision against a "rainy day" by accumulative Dividends, also make provision against Fire, &c., and insure through your own Society. Proposals for Insurance against Fire, Death, Accident, Burglary can be effected by us, and Proposal Forms may be had on application at the office.
