COMMITTEE'S REPORT.

FELLOW-MEMBERS,

We present herewith for your consideration and approval our Report for the last Quarter, ended April 13th, 1940.

SALES.—The Sales for the Quarter were £85,735, as compared to £95,235 for the previous Quarter, and £90,165 for the corresponding Quarter of last

MEMBERSHIP.—The membership on April 13th, 1940, was 11,126; at the beginning of the Quarter it was 11,044. New Members have joined to the number of 155, and 73 have left the district or withdrawn.

MEMBERS' PURCHASES.—These average 11s. 10¼d. per week, while for the previous Quarter they equalled 13s. 2d. per week. For the corresponding period of last Year they were 12s. 8¼d. per week.

BREAD OUTPUT.—The Bread output for this Quarter was 73,121 stones, and for the previous Quarter it was 72,703 stones, while for the corresponding period of last Year it equalled 71,787 stones.

DAIRY DEPARTMENT.—The number of gallons of Milk sold from the Dairy during the period under review was 7,608 of Tuberculin Tested, and 47,642 of Pasteurised, a total of 55,250 gallons. For the previous Quarter the sales were 7,661 of Tuberculin Tested and 47,693 of Pasteurised, a total of 55,354 gallons. For the corresponding period of last Year the sales were 13,752 gallons of Tuberculin Tested and 37,869 gallons of Pasteurised, a total of 51,621 gallons.

INTERIM DIVIDEND.—The Committee is pleased to be able to recommend the payment of an interim Dividend of 1s. 6d. in the £. With rationing, our sales of staple commodities have gone down. Retail prices as well as qualities are fixed in certain cases, and under the Prices of Goods Act the net margin on many articles is restricted. Trading expenses have naturally increased.

We know from our experience in the last war that this Society will pull through better than most traders, and the Committee is confident of the Society's ability to meet the present situation with equal success.

The Dividend will be paid out in the Co-operative Assembly Hall, Colehill, Tamworth, on Thursday, Friday, and Saturday, June 6th, 7th, and 8th.

SHARE BOOKS.—You will see printed the list of Members' Share Books not in for audit on March 2nd.

We are glad more of our Members have fetched out their Pass Books since being requested to do so, and we require you to send them in for audit regularly, so that they are duly made up, and to have the auditor's inspection.

GENERAL.

COAL CLUB.-With a view to assisting our Members with their purchases of Coal we have commenced a Coal Club to enable them to take one-ton loads during the period May 1st to August 31st in any year. The club cards may be obtained from the office.

The value of the coal must be paid off in sixteen weeks from the date of receiving the club.

Repayments to be made strictly weekly and not at irregular intervals, and clubs will only be granted to registered coal customers.

PAPER SUPPLIES .- Owing to the Government control of all paper we have been cut down in our usual supplies, and therefore it is not possible for each Member to have a quarterly report as heretofore.

Our deliverers will bring them to those interested upon application, but we have loose forms for the authorisation of the payment of Dividend in addition to those usually found in the report, and these can be had upon request from the roundsmen or the office and other departments.

COMMITTEE FEES .- You will see from the agenda for the Quarterly Meeting we are recommending an increase in our fees. These have been of the same amount for about twenty years, and with the increased responsibility of the position we feel a more equitable remuneration should be paid.

We are feeling the effects of the war now in regard to supplies of goods, rationing,

transport, labour, &c., and have done our best to meet the position.

Since the outbreak of war 28 employees of this Society have joined H.M. Forces. We feel sure that all Members will join the Committee in wishing them good luck and a speedy return after victory. Employees on active service received a message of greeting and a small goodwill gift from the Society at Christmas.

Thanks are due to Members who have borne the inevitable wartime shopping difficulties with tolerance and good humour. Our staff is working conscientiously to overcome these difficulties as far as possible, but some hardships cannot be avoided. When the Society's service does not quite rise to peacetime standards—and this is bound to happen now and then—we ask Members to remember that Rome-Berlin Axis, and not the Society, is responsible for the war. Petrol rationing and the lack of materials and labour have caused traffic

difficulties within the Society as elsewhere. The Society can still deliver Members' weekly orders if these are left at the shops not later than two days before the usual weekly day of delivery. At other times Members are asked to carry their parcels home with them.

Mr. Walton, one of the nominees at the last Quarterly Meeting for a seat on the Committee, has sent a letter withdrawing his nomination, therefore there are four nominees for three vacancies to be voted upon on Wednesday, June 5th, 1940. Thanking you for the support accorded to the Society in the past and hoping

for a continuance of same.

NOTICES.

Every Member is particularly requested to peruse the following, and their compliance with same is asked for:

CHRISTMAS CLUB.—Deposits received at any time in any Department or the Office from January 1st to December 1st. Allowances in goods as follows: For 5s. deposited, goods allowed to 5s. 3d.; for 10s. deposited, goods allowed to 10s. 6d.; for 15s. deposited, goods allowed to 15s. 9d.; for 20s. deposited, goods allowed to 21s. Further particulars given on application.

MEMBERS' ATTENTION is directed to Rule XX., whereby they may nominate the party to whom the money standing to their credit may be paid at their decease. If Members would attend to this rule the money could be transferred at their death free of expense, and those entitled to receive the money saved a considerable amount of trouble.

SMALL SAVINGS BANK.—Deposits are received at any time during office hours. Sums from 1d. to 10s. may be deposited, but not more than £20 can be on deposit at one time. Interest at the rate of £3 per cent per annum is paid on each sum of 4s. remaining on deposit for three months.

LOANS.—Deposits received at any time during office hours. Interest at the rate of £2.10s, per cent per annum.

MEMBERS CHANGING THEIR ADDRESS should intimate the same to the Secretary. A Form is placed at the end of this Report for that purpose, and much annoyance will be saved to the staff if we can be advised of any alteration.

HIRE PURCHASE SCHEME.—Goods are let out on Hire Purchase terms from the Furnishing Department. A leaflet giving full details of the scheme may be obtained from that Department.

TWENTY WEEKS CLUB.—We have in operation a Twenty Weeks Club for goods from the Drapery, Millinery, Outfitting, Boots, Chemistry, or Coal Departments. Vouchers of £1 minimum and £5 maximum are issued from the Office, to be repaid at the rate of 1s. per £ per week.

CO-OPERATIVE INSURANCE.—We are in a position to effect Insurances of all kinds—Life, Fire, Burglary, Motor, Live Stock, and Accident.

The risk is covered by the Joint Insurance Department of the C.W.S. and S.C.W.S., and Co-operators should be convinced of the necessity of some Insurance and apply at once to the Office for all information relating to the various branches of our Insurance business.

NATIONAL HEALTH INSURANCE.—Under the C.W.S. we are an Approved Section for the purposes of the Insurance under the Act. As in every other business, so in this, we want our Members and their sons and daughters to take their benefit through this Society. We claim to be able to do this business with promptness and with a minimum of expense.

WITHDRAWALS of Share Capital and Dividend can only be paid to the actual owner of the Shares, unless the person sent is provided with written authority and a Notice of Withdrawal Form duly signed by such owner of Shares. The Share Pass Book or Pass Card must be produced whenever a contribution to or a withdrawal from Shares is made. Children should not be sent to the Office either to receive or to pay money.

SHARE and SMALL SAVINGS BOOKS should be sent in regularly to be made up and audited, and the importance of this cannot be too strongly impressed upon Members. When left, the Pass Card should have the amount standing in the Share Book entered thereon and same initialled.

THE CURRENT QUARTER ends on July 13th, 1940, and Share Books should be sent in by the 6th day of month following.

DIVIDEND WILL BE PAID AT THE CENTRAL ON THURSDAY, FRIDAY, AND SATURDAY, JUNE 6th, 7th, and 8th, between the hours of 10 a.m. to 12 noon, 1-30 to 4 p.m., and 4-30 to 6 p.m. Members are requested to bring their Pass Cards for production at the time of payment. - Vouchers may be exchanged for goods at any or all of the following Departments: Drapery, Millinery, Outfitting, Boots, Furnishing, Crockery, Chemistry (Optical, Dentistry, &c.), Coal, and must be spent within three weeks from the date issued, being retained by the Department on final purchase.
- Subscriptions may be paid at any of the following Departments: Drapery, Millinery, Outfitting, Boots, and Furnishing, or Office, when the Card must be produced.
- A Climax Check for Full Dividend will be given when payments are completed, on production of the Deposit Card at the Office.
