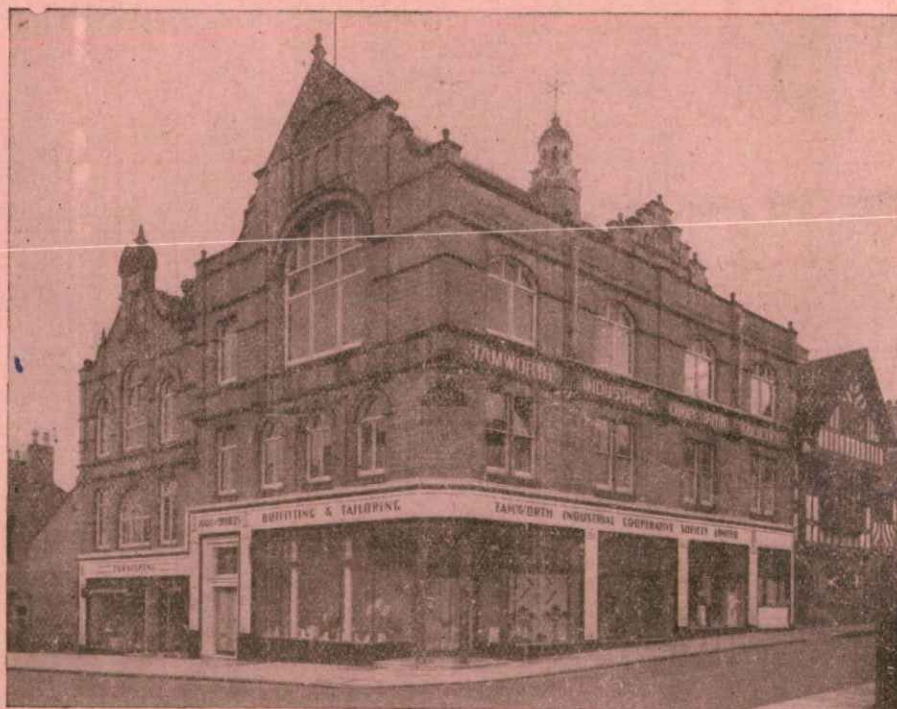

COMMITTEE'S REPORT.

FELLOW-MEMBERS,

Our Report for the Half Year ended July 14th, 1941, together with the Accounts covering the same period, is presented to you for approval after perusal.

TRADE.—The Sales for the Half Year were £178,722, as compared to £196,889 for the previous Half Year and £180,471 for the corresponding period of last year.

The trade of our departments is affected by the imposition of the purchase tax, limitation of supplies, and rationing of commodities, and much more trade could have been done if the commodities had been available for sale.

MEMBERSHIP.—This is now 11,480. At the beginning of the Half Year it was 11,318; 322 persons have been admitted to membership, and 160 have withdrawn or left the district, there being a net increase of 162.

SHARE CAPITAL.—The value of the Members' Share Capital on July 14th, 1941, was £369,374, this showing an increase of £15,563 over the previous Half Year's claim.

SMALL SAVINGS.—The claims in this section at the end of the Half Year were £13,388, as compared to £12,958 at the beginning of the period, there being an increase of £430.

LOAN CAPITAL.—In the Loan Account the balance at the end of the Half Year is £88,491, while at the commencement it was £82,428, showing an increase of £6,063. It is pleasing to see such increases of Capital invested by our Members, showing a confidence in the Society.

INVESTMENTS.—On the reinvested Capital a small profit of £179 has been made. In view of the difficulty in securing high rates of interest combined with security we consider this as satisfactory. We have £428,838 Capital reinvested in good securities.

PURCHASES.—During the Half Year the Purchases were £129,897, being made up of £104,213 from the Co-operative Wholesale Society Limited, £18,662 from Private Traders, £4,865 from Productive Societies, and £2,157 from Local Firms. The Departmental Purchases from the C.W.S. were:—

BREAD OUTPUT.—The output of Bread for the last Half Year was 176,577 stones, for the previous Half Year it was 157,234 stones, and for the corresponding period of last year 148,098 stones.

DAIRY DEPARTMENT.—During the Half Year 177,893 gallons of Pasteurised Milk were sold from the Dairy. For the previous Half Year it was 138,713 of Pasteurised and 6,373 of Tuberculin Tested. For the corresponding period of last year the sales were 99,082 Pasteurised and 14,313 of Tuberculin Tested. We regret not being able to obtain supplies of Tuberculin Tested Milk for those of our Members who desired this commodity.

MEMBERS' PURCHASES.—The average weekly purchase per Member during the Half Year was 11s. 11.7d. For the last Half Year it was 13s. 4.5d. For the corresponding period of last year it equalled 12s. 5.1d. Taking the actual purchasing Members the average per week is 14s. 9.5d.

SURPLUS DISPOSABLE.—The Surplus Disposable for the Half Year is £9,050. 11s. 9d. We recommend it be distributed as follows:—

If Members would attend to this rule the money could be transferred at their death free of expense, and those entitled to receive the money saved a considerable amount of trouble.

CO-OPERATIVE INSURANCE.—We are in a position to effect Insurances of all kinds—Life, Fire, Burglary, Motor, Live Stock, and Accident.

The risk is covered by the Joint Insurance Department of the C.W.S. and S.C.W.S., and Co-operators should be convinced of the necessity of some Insurance and apply at once to the Office for all information relating to the various branches of our Insurance business.

NATIONAL HEALTH INSURANCE.—Under the C.W.S. we are an Approved Section for the purposes of the Insurance under the Act. As in every other business, so in this, we want our Members and their sons and daughters to take their benefit through this Society. We claim to be able to do this business with promptness and with a minimum of expense.

WITHDRAWALS of Share Capital and Dividend can only be paid to the actual owner of the Shares, unless the person sent is provided with written authority and a Notice of Withdrawal Form duly signed by such owner of Shares. The Share Pass Book or Pass Card must be produced whenever a contribution to or a withdrawal from Shares is made. Children should not be sent to the Office either to receive or to pay money.

SHARE and SMALL SAVINGS BOOKS should be sent in regularly to be made up and audited, and the importance of this cannot be too strongly impressed upon Members. When left, the Pass Card should have the amount standing in the Share Book entered thereon and same initialled.
